Analysis Report on Students' Satisfaction Survey regarding Teaching-Learning Evaluation 2021-2022

Feedback from students during the academic year 2021-2022 were analyzed based on a five point measurement scale. 82 students responded through an online survey. Twenty parameters are analyzed.


The students involved in the survey were of the age group between 19 and 24 and most of the responses were from the age group 20 (24.4%) and 21 (47.6%). Out of 84 students about 81.7% were girls and most of the respondents were from Bachelor's degree programs. Most responses were from pupil pursuing their study in Arts subject (50%) followed by science (26.8%), commerce (13.4%), professional degree (6.1%) and others (3.7%)









21. Give your observation/suggestions to improve the overall teaching-learning experience in your institution

There were a total of 82 responses, among them, 68 students gave some suggestions. About 20 students were fully satisfied with the current teaching learning evaluation pursued in the institution and they recorded it as excellent or very good. About 6 suggested e-learning/ advanced learning technologies in classrooms. Some students suggested (5) interactive teaching methods. 5 students suggested the need of student centred as well as activity based learning while 12 demanded more computer availability to students. About 5 students emphasized the need of teachers becoming more friendly while 2 suggested that the teachers must be strict. Some demanded more books in the library for their respective subjects (4) while others demanded (3) more project works, study tours (1), skill development programs (2), outdoor classes (3), seminars (1) and computer awareness classes (2). Suggestions like syllabus modification (2), more material facilities (1) experiential learning (3) and social learning (2) etc were also recorded in the survey. Need of improvement in extra and co-curricular activities was mentioned by two of the students. Students suggested improvement in infrastructure facilities(2). Some opined that exams should be conducted at the right time (1) and more class wise test papers should be conducted (1) (MCQ) type. About 12 students gave no suggestion at all while 4 pupils did not respond to this question.

More focus to be laid on inculcating soft skill and life skills during the course

Need modern teaching aids

Teachers should be more approachable

Inadequate availability of certain resources.

Ensure good material facilities

The Institution as such is maintaining an average standard but individual performance of departments is remarkable

Adopt new technology based methods for overall improvement of the college

Need more opportunities for extra curricular activities
