In the 1 hour lecture, the resource person discussed in detail the origins, evolutions and scope of cultural studies in academic fields of inquiry. 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Staff Club of St. Thomas College, Ranni organised a webinar on the topic "Career Advancement and Promotion" for college teachers on 23rd October 2020.






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Webinar for the students of the Department

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Talk on Stress Management in association with JCI YUVA, Kottayam - 15th February 2021




Stress is your body's response to changes in your life. Because life involves constant change, ranging from everyday. Taking time to manage your stress is essential in order to teach effectively and to help students with their stress around learning. Stress can be effectively managed in many different ways. The best stress management plans usually include a mix of stress relievers that address stress physically and psychologically and help to develop resilience and coping skills. So relieving the stress among the teachers, women cell organized a talk on Stress Management in association with JCI YUVA, Kottayam on 15th February 2021. The keynote speaker was JCL Sen. Justin Thomas, National trainer. He stated various stress relief techniques that can work in just a few minutes to calm the body's stress response. These techniques offer a "quick fix" that helps you feel calmer at the moment, and this can help in several ways. He also pointed that when our stress response is not triggered, we may approach problems more thoughtfully and proactively.

Nipping our stress response in the bud can also keep us from experiencing chronic stress. Quick stress relievers like breathing exercises were practiced during the session. It was actually a stress relieving class for all of us and the day witnessed a whole hearted participation from the college family.
