Feedback from students about the curriculum during the academic year 2020-2021 was analyzed in an offline mode based on a percentage scale. 280 students participated in the feedback analysis. About 48% of the students expressed excellent responses about the depth of course content as well as the relevance of the curriculum. Nearly 73% gave a good opinion that the syllabus is enriched with ethical values. 78% gave a good opinion that the curriculum maintains a good balance between theory and application.

Analysis Report on Alumni Feedback on Curriculum 2020-2021

Feedback from alumni about the curriculum during the academic year 2020-2021 was analysed based on a percentage scale. 172 alumni participated in the survey. 50% of alumni gave excellent responses that the curriculum assures the holistic development of students. A very small group approximately 2.3 expressed concern about the applicability of the course to meet the real-life situations.

Analysis Report on Parents' Feedback on Curriculum Aspects and General Aspects of the Institution 2020-2021

The parents' feedback was evaluated on seven parameters in an online mode. 84 parents participated in the survey. Three-fourths of the parent community is satisfied with the admission procedures in college. More than half have an opinion that the curriculum is relevant for higher education and provides ethical values among students. Above three-fourths of the community suggested that the discipline and quality of teaching in college are good. About three-quarters agreed that the semester system is productive and the syllabus is career oriented. Even though fifty percent of parents were satisfied with the publication of results, a small share of the people was anxious about the publication of results in time.

- Environmental-related projects should be encouraged.

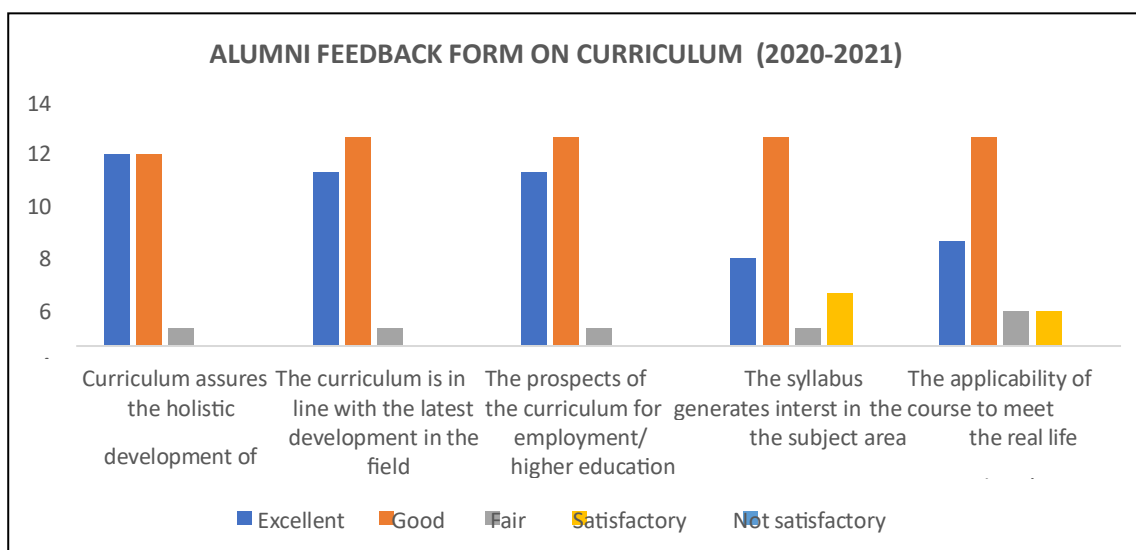

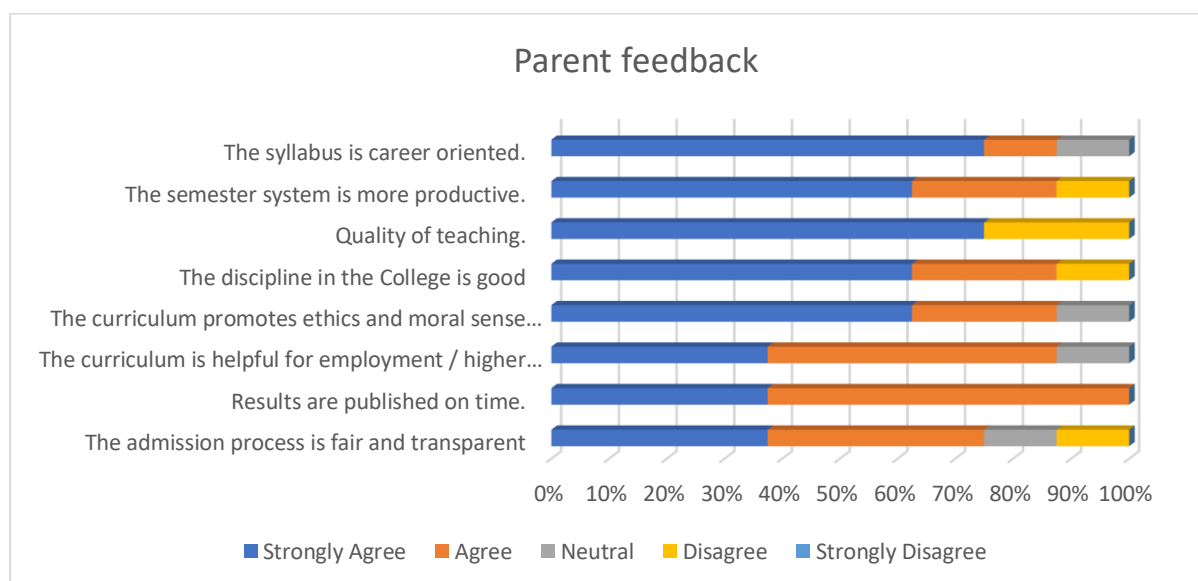
Analysis Report

But they felt that the syllabus couldn't impart much practical knowledge due to the pandemic, especially in the absence of offline classes. They have suggested incorporating more strategies to enrich the knowledge-sharing process.

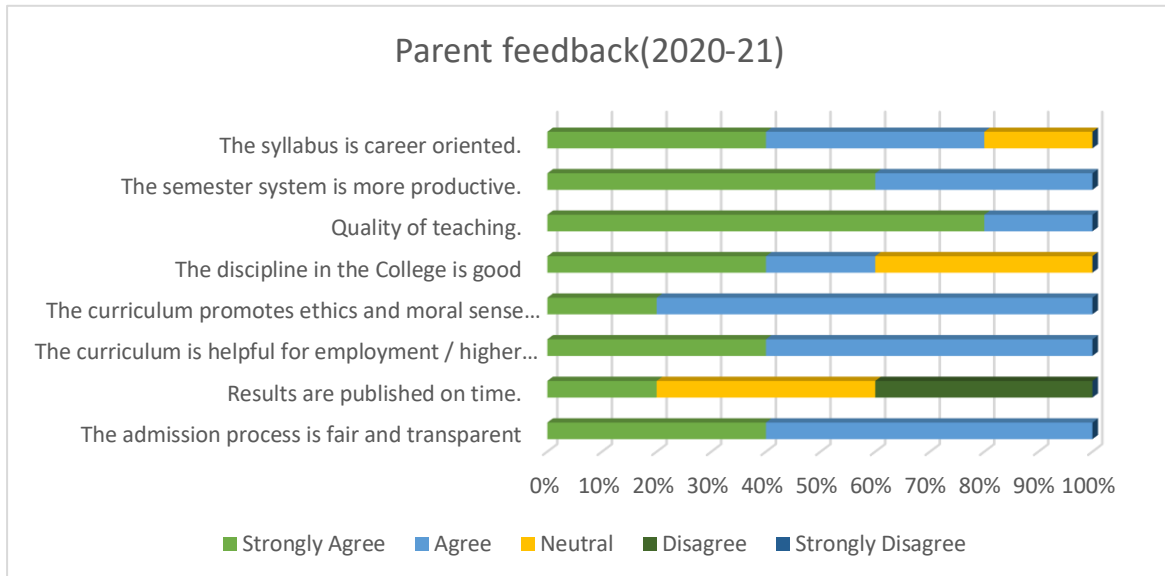
3. Alumni Feedback on Curriculum



Analysis Report

Several aspects of the curriculum have been rated excellent by the Alumni. Out of the 9 alumni who participated in the feedback, 90% agreed that the curriculum is in line with the latest development in the field. Only 10% rated fair for the applicability of the course to meet real-life situations. 90% found that the curriculum has excellent prospects for employment/higher education. Only 10% rated fair for the ability of the syllabus to generate interest in the subject area. They suggested that the syllabus may be disseminated more interestingly catering to the students' needs.

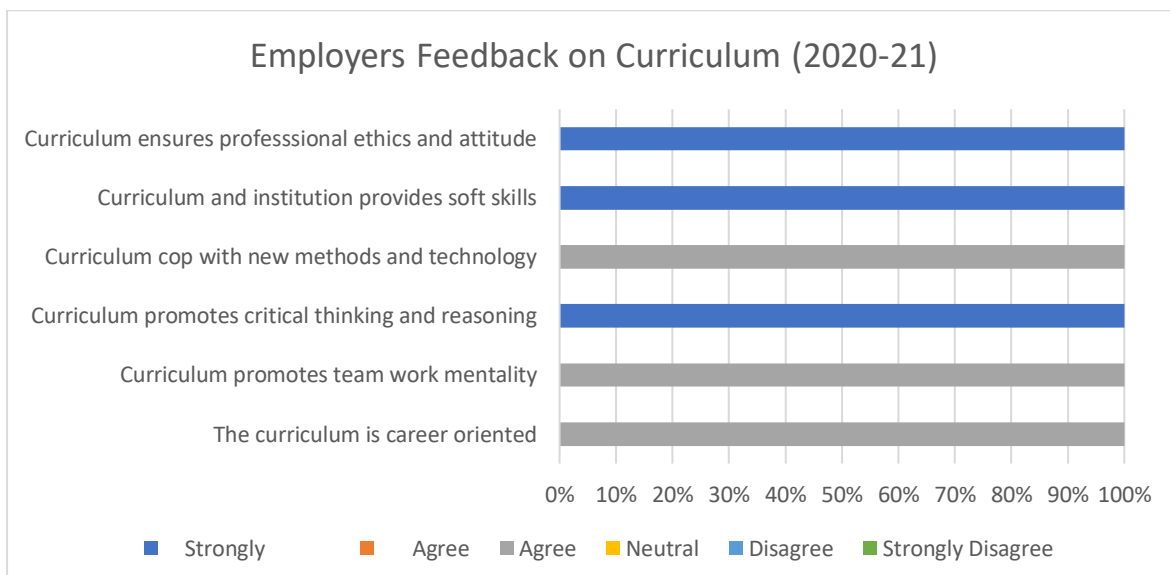
4. Parent Feedback on Curriculum & Institution
